

The Filipino-Australian Association of the Northern Territory had its beginning from the original Filipino Association of the Northern Territory (FANT) formed by a small group of professional Filipino-Australians in October 1973.

Under the leadership of Lino Molina as the first President, the association made an impressionable presence in the Darwin community through social gatherings characterised by cultural displays of dances, costumes, food and hospitality.

Our initial mission was simple - to gain the trust back from the community by focusing on providing free services, reforming existing events, developing more benefits to financial members and repairing our facility in Marrara to show that we are true to our mission. 2020-2022 EVENTS AND ACTIVITIES

- 2020 Opened the donation hub to support those who were affected by the pandemic and were not eligible for government support. 18 weeks of operation, distributed over 3000 grocery packs
- Collaborated with other multicultural communities through event participation
- Fence upgrade (special thanks to Raul Daet)
- Barrio Fiesta 2020
- Barrio Fiesta 2021 Outdoor stage
- Strengthen our ties with the Darwin Malayalee Association and the Nep Association of the NT
- Acknowledge and celebrate the relationship of the First Nations people and the Filipino Community, recognising the descendants of the Filipino Pearl Divers, the Manilamen in the 1800s by making sure they are invited and present at our events
- Formed the Filipino Youth group, PHLtheBEAT (performed in 20+ including major events in the NT and SA)
- Collaborated with Skinnyfish Music to develop our young artists
- Filipino presence in Darwin Festival 2020 with James Mangohig
- Upgraded our website goal is make it a hub of information for all Filipinos in the NT
- A 'beach party' to celebrate our Filipino international students at Dela Plage Cafe
- Partnered with Migration Corporation Australia and provided free immigration Q&A through a Facebook live session with Ms, Margie Dizon
- Implemented FAANT's sponsorship levels and benefits and increased its sponsors and partners from 0 to 19 in 1 year and a half
- Established FAANT's Member-based scheme, partnered with 15 local businesses. More to come.
- Organised a relief gig fundraiser for the survivors of Typhoon Rai which collected more than \$10,000AUD. (December, 2021)
- 2022 Filipino Community Centre stage repair
- 2022 Filipino Community Centre kitchen repair
- Increased the Filipino presence in major events in Darwin Darwin Festival, Darwin Fringe Festival, Barunga Festival, Laksa Festival, Territory Day 2022
- Celebrated Philippine Independence Day at the Parliament House hosted by Minister for Multicultural Affairs, the Hon Ngaree Ah Kit MLA
- PHLtheBEAT, our youth group, collaboration with Sanderson Middle School
- Hosted the biggest Filipino festival in the history of the Filipino Community in the Territory - HALA BIRA 2022, the 25th Barrio Fiesta celebration held at Darwin Waterfront on 27 Aug 2022 (7000+ attendees)

BUT, WE CAN DO MORE... FUTURE PROJECTS (OUR HOPES)

- Improve FAANT's financial position
- Improve our membership programs and correspondence with our financial members
- Collaborate more with sports
- Produce shows inviting international artists in collaboration with our local artists to increase FAANT's revenue
- Support smaller organisations and their events (once we have stabilised our finances)
- Open our gates to all types of events, make the Filipino Community Centre an event space for everyone to use especially for the multicultural communities
- Main hall bathroom repair and upgrade
- Small building full upgrade, renovation and repair to include decent offices (for FAANT and NANT), bigger storage rooms and a potential recording studio and band/dance rehearsal room open for everyone (there is currently none in the N. suburbs)
- Once urgent and major repairs are completed, we aim to increase our events through collaborations with other event organisers in Darwin
 - Youth events
 - concerts
 - meeting place
 - workshops
 - sports activities
- Fund our youth to participate in interstate and overseas cultural and leadership programs and events to hone their skills and abilities
- Collaborate more with OMA, OYA, MCNT to provide further and better support to the multicultural community and to our youth
- Develop FAANT's outdoor area Gazebo and benches for garden events
- Repair of the basketball court remove the existing court and relocate half court only to utilise the space for more for events
- Place an outdoor gym equipment open for everyone to use. There is currently none in the Northern Suburbs
- As all FAANT committee members work full-time, appoint 1 paid admin support to help us with our goals and hopes for the community
